Job and Family Services Department's Holiday Hours

Cincinnati (Dec. 21, 2010) Hamilton County's Job and Family Services Department will close at noon on Dec. 23 and remain closed until Monday, Dec. 27. The agency will close again for New Year's Eve.

The Job and Family Services Department assists Hamilton County residents with child protection, elder protection, child support collection and public assistance. The agency's 241-KIDS (child protection) and 421-LIFE (elder protection) will be available through the holiday and caseworkers will be on hand to respond if necessary.
