Grant Name: Safety Net Dental Care Program

Funder: Ohio Department of Health

Eligibility: All applicants must be a

local public or non-profit agency.

Award Range/Funding Period: \$175,000 for the calendar/fiscal year 2008, with lower continuation awards for FY09.

Summary: The purpose of the Safety Net Dental Care Program is to provide access to comprehensive dental care services for a significant number of Ohioans who cannot afford and would not otherwise receive dental care (by offsetting costs of uncompensated care) and to reduce disparities in access to dental care. The Safety Net Dental Care Program is designed to provide comprehensive dental care through safety net dental clinics, school-based dental care and mobile/portable dental care programs. Funds may be requested to help support the cost of clinic operations (personnel, supplies, etc.) and/or for the start-up of new or the expansion of existing safety net programs, including capital costs (e.g., renovations, large equipment). The Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Oral Health Services grant funds are intended to leverage other program resources to provide services.

Due Date: Notice of Intent to apply is due 9-10-07; the application is due 10-15-07.

Grant Name: Dental Sealant Program
Funder: Ohio Department of Health
Eligibility: All applicants for dental

sealant grant funds must be a local public or non-profit agency.

Award Range/Funding Period: A total of \$736,000 is available to be awarded among 18-20 Dental Sealant programs for FY/Calendar Year 08.

Summary: The purpose of the Dental Sealant Program is to assist providers of public health services to develop and implement programs to improve access to dental sealants for high-risk children. Grant funds may be requested to expand existing dental sealant programs; however, the funds may not be used to substitute for current budgetary resources, except ODH Dental Sealant Program grant funds. The Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Oral Health Services grant funds are intended to leverage other program resources to provide services.

Due Date: A Notice of Intent to Apply is due 9-17-07; the application is due 10-22-07 on GMIS.

Grant Name: Youth Literacy Grants

Funder: Dollar General Foundation

Eligibility: Non-profits.

Award Range/Funding Period: \$3,000 maximum award.

Summary: The Dollar General Youth Literacy Grants provide funding to schools, public libraries and nonprofit organizations to

help with the implementation or expansion of literacy programs for students who are below grade level or experiencing difficulty reading.

Funder: BridgeBuilders

Foundation

Eligibility: 501 (c) (3)s.

Award Range/Funding Period: \$2,000 - \$5,000. Preference is given to non profit organizations in Western Pennsylvania, but projects throughout the US may apply.

Summary: The intent of the foundation is to support small, community-based organizations working to build bridges between groups of people that differ with respect to age, race, gender, economic resources, and physical or mental ability. A further objective is to fund projects that actively promote social, economic and environmental justice. In recent years, the foundation has made it a top priority to support programs that encourage young people to broaden their experience and contribute to society. Projects that are initiated by young people and those that address the needs of minority and low-income youth are of particular interest to BridgeBuilders.
