**Grant Name:** Grants for the Integration of Schools and Mental Health Systems, CFDA # 84.215M

**Funder:** US Dept of Education

**Eligibility:** State educational agencies, local educational agencies (LEAs), including charter schools that are considered LEAs under State law.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** No funds are currently appropriated for this program. However, the Department is inviting applications to allow enough time to complete the grant process if Congress appropriates funds for this program. Estimated award range is \$150,000 - \$350,000, for project periods up to 18 months.

**Summary:** Grants for the Integration of Schools and Mental Health Systems will provide funds to increase student access to high-quality mental health care by developing innovative approaches that link school systems with the local mental health system.

**Grant Name:** Feed Ohio: Summer Food Service Program Support

**Funder:** Ohio Department of Job & Family Services

**Eligibility:** Ohio 501(c)(3)s who have been approved by ODE (via Appendix A, Ohio SFSP Site Application) to set up at least two new

and certifiable SFSP sites in areas with demonstrated need as determined by ODE.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** Not specified.

**Summary:** The Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services (ODJFS) releases this Request for Grant Applications (RFGA) on behalf of the Governor's Office for Faith Based and Community Initiatives (GOFBCI) for the purpose of selecting up to 40 faith-based and/or community organizations for the 2008 Feed Ohio: Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) Support grants. The selected grantees will serve as USDA SFSP "sponsors" that will establish at least two new SFSP sites with enrichment programs that accompany the SFSP meal during the Summer of 2008. An authorized Ohio SFSP Site Application (see **Appendix A**) must be completed and included with the grant proposal to ensure that the sponsor and the new sites are pre-approved to run the SFSP by the Ohio Department of Education (ODE). Awarded Feed Ohio grantees must begin providing services by June 2008 and maintain services for a minimum of eight weeks.
