SMALLER GRANTS



Grant Name: Two grant areas: Early Childhood Care and Education; Cutie Patootie Center.

Funder: Rosie's For All Kids Foundation

Eligibility: 501(c) (3) nonprofit organizations dedicated to helping disadvantaged children and low-income families through early childhood care and education and other essential programs. First priority is given to experienced, community-based programs serving children in low-income areas, where many families struggle to find affordable, high-quality early education and care.

Award Range/Funding Period: Early Childhood grants: \$15,000 - \$30,000 for 12 months; Cutie Patootie grants are not specified.

Summary: Early Childhood grants will fund tuition subsidies; small renovations, supplies and equipment upgrades; playground construction; staff development opportunities; Cutie Patootie grants will fund capital campaign funding in major urban areas with the goal of expanding services to a significant number of children from low-income families. Projects include the expansion of a building, the renovation of a newly purchased building, or the

construction of a new building on a vacant site. The resulting center will include an area or a set of classrooms with the Cutie Patootie™ Center name.

Due Date: Not specified. Interested parties must complete an on-line eligibility quiz as a first step.

Grant Name: Development Funds Grant Proposals.

Funder: US Handball Association

Eligibility: Any person or group interested in starting a handball program may submit a proposal.

Award Range/Funding Period: Awards are based on availability of funds (size and period not specified).

Summary: The USHA funds projects that promote the development of handball. Programs may be organized within school instruction, after-school programs, or community or club/Y programs. Due to the limitations of funding, the USHA is not in a position to fund the building of facilities. The USHA prefers to not fund administrative costs, but actual program and equipment expenses.
