**Grant Name:** Standing Announcement for the Ethnic Community Self-Help Program, CFDA # 93.576

**Funder:** US Dept of

HHS/ACF/Office of Refugee Services.

**Eligibility:** Public or private nonprofit agencies and faith-based and community organizations are eligible applicants.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** Maximum award is \$200,000 per budget period, for a 36 month project (3 budget periods).

**Summary:** The Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) invites the submission of applications for funding, on a competitive basis, to connect newcomer refugees and their communities with community resources. The objective of this program is to strengthen organized ethnic communities comprised and representative of refugee populations to ensure ongoing support and services to refugees after initial resettlement. ORR is interested in applications from national, regional (multi-state) or local refugee community organizations that address community building, facilitate cultural adjustment and integration of refugees, and deliver mutually supportive functions such as information exchange, civic participation, resource enhancement, orientation and support to newly arriving refugees (and other refugees that maybe in need of such assistance regardless of their resettlement date) and public education to the larger community on the background, needs and potential of refugees.

**Grant Name:** Standing Announcement for Supplemental Services for Recently Arrived

Refugees, CFDA # 93.576

**Funder:** US Dept of HHS/ACF/Office of Refugee Services.

**Eligibility:** Public or private nonprofit agencies and faith-based and community organizations are eligible applicants.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** Maximum award is \$500,000 over a budget/project period of 17 months.

**Summary:** The Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) invites the submission of applications for funding, on a competitive basis, for Supplemental Services for Recently Arrived Refugees to provide services to arriving refugees or sudden and unexpected large secondary migration of refugees where communities are not sufficiently prepared in terms of linguistic or culturally appropriate services.

**Grant Name:** 2008 Adolescent Family Life (AFL) Demonstration Projects, CFDA # 93.995

**Funder:** US Dept of HHS/Office of Public Health and Science

**Eligibility:** Any public or private nonprofit organization or agency, including a faith-based and community organization, is eligible to apply for a grant. However, only those organizations or agencies that demonstrate the capability of providing and thoroughly evaluating a multi-site model as stipulated in this announcement will be considered for grant awards.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** Maximum award is \$800,000 per budget year, for a project period of 5 years.

**Summary:** These grants are for projects to develop, implement and evaluate a multi-site primary abstinence education program targeting youth ages 12-18, as compared with a multi-site "enriched" program model. This announcement defines a primary abstinence education program as 15-25 hours of abstinence education and supportive services and activities conducted within one year with the same participants.

**Grant Name:** Community-Based Abstinence Education Program, CFDA # 93.010

**Funder:** US Dept of Education

**Eligibility:** State governments, county governments, city or township governments, independent school districts, public and state-controlled institutions of higher education, Public/Indian Housing Authorities, non-profits with 501(c)(3) IRS status (other than institutions of higher education), non-profits without 501(c)(3) IRS status (other than institutions of higher education), private institutions of higher education, for-profit organizations (other than small businesses), small businesses, special district governments.

**Award Range/Funding Period:** \$600,000 per budget period, with 5 budget periods (60 months).

**Summary:** The purpose of this program is to educate young people and create an environment within communities that supports teen decisions to postpone sexual activity until marriage. Acceptable applications will be designed to provide abstinence-until-marriage education as defined by Section 510(b)(2) of the Social Security Act, for adolescents aged 12 through 18.
